The Presbytery of South Carolina met at Aveleigh Presbyterian Church in Newberry on May 17, with over 60 in attendance. It was good meeting with Rev. Dr. Brian Stewart giving an update. Dr. Steward is a friend of Rock at First Presbyterian Church in Greenville. He has recently taken the position of Director of Global Enrichment for ECO. He discussed the many opportunities of alliances with many denominations in Africa and South America that are on the horizon. This included the fact that PCUSA has withdrawn support for their foreign missionaries. He also recommended the *Discover the Bible* app which not only educates but prompts you to do something with that knowledge.

There was also encouragement for covenant partners to help at the Presbytery level with committees and positions. (Our own Herman Fletcher is Clerk and Bob Young is Treasurer.) The leadership of the Presbytery of SC is a five year plan so that by the last year each church would be visited by a member of Presbytery leadership one to two times a year.



Songs from Psalms

The book of Psalms was written by many authors, with King David writing the most, 73 of them. Other authors include Moses, Solomon, and Asaph who is attributed with 12. Today many of our traditional hymns and contemporary songs are based on the Psalms. These songs help us to meditate on God's word and deepen our relationship with God. The "Psalms Project" is an initiative by a diverse group of musicians to set all 150 Psalms to music. During the months of June and July the Sanctuary Choir will be singing anthems based on the Psalms. Some of these may be familiar to you. "The Majesty and Glory of Your Name" by Tom Fettke is based on Psalm 8. "On Eagle's Wings" by Michael Joncas is based on Psalm 91. Goodness of God" by Bethel Music is based on Psalm 107.
