August 24, 12:15 p.m. -3:00 p.m. Lake Day: Let's Make a Splash!





Anthem Arrangers

Most songs and hymns begin as a single melody written by a composer. Then verses are added with a complementary tune. Anthem arrangers take these songs, some theirs, some written by other composers, and add parts for Bass, Tenor, Alto, and Soprano singers to create anthems. A few of the most renown arrangers for church choir anthems are Lloyd Larson, Tom Fettke, Mary McDonald (who wrote our 250th anniversary anthem) and Don Besig. This past week beloved Presbyterian composer/arranger Hal Hopson, passed away at the age of 92. Over his career he published more than 3,000 music works for children, youth, and adult choirs, and compositions for organ, piano, and handbells. His most popular song is "The Gift of Love" which is based on 1 Corinthians 13. He also arranged a major cantata "God with Us", which was chosen to be placed in a time capsule at the Kennedy Space Center during the American Bicentennial in 1976. In the 11:00 a.m. Sunday bulletin we list the composer or arranger of the choir anthem. We give thanks to God for the composers and arrangers who bless our church with their talents of music. our church with their talents of music.

Emergency Response Team Information

Rock Presbyterian Church (ECO) is very fortunate to have numerous medical personnel (retired and otherwise) who have availed themselves to respond to any medical emergencies that might occur during church activities. The Palliative Care Ministry Team, with the guidance of Dr. Bill Mallow, has led the way to gather necessary supplies and educate this wonderful group of volunteers. If you have any concerns or any questions, feel free to contact any of the members of the Palliative Care Ministry Team: Judy Lentz, Margaret Moore, Linda Goldstein, Lee Goldstein, Kaye Brock, and Carrie Murdock. Contact information is available in the online church directory.

"Prior Preparation Prevents Poor Performance" so to better prepare our church for medical emergencies, we now have 5 Red Medical Bags.

These bags are equipped for emergencies and contain automatic blood pressure monitors, oximeters, and almost anything you might need in an emergency situation until EMS can arrive. Bags located near eating areas and the van contains a Life Vacuum for a choking situation. One bag is to be on our church van whenever it is in use. Other bags are located in a cabinet under the AED's (multipurpose building, upstairs fellowship hall, overflow room between sanctuary and choir room, and the mission house). Small First Aid kits with band aids, etc., for minor injuries can also be found in the cabinets under the AED's. Safety is everyone's responsibility!
