While these continue to be interesting and challenging days for sure, we seek to be faithful in serving our Lord and his church. If you have been paying attention to the news, you know that there has been a rise in numbers of Covid-19 cases in SC, and even locally here in the Lakelands. Proof of this was highlighted last week in an article in the New York Times that listed Greenwood as #5 for rapidly rising cases of Covid. The dramatically increased numbers of confirmed cases make clear the need for the session to make a slight adjustment to the current Sunday schedule. After hearing from staff and the worship chairs, we have voted to return to one service, beginning this Sunday, June 28. The weekly Sunday service will return to 10:00 a.m. We will continue worship both in person in the sanctuary (social distanced, masks, and sign ups) or via the live stream on Facebook or our homepage (www.rpcgwd.org).

It is our prayer that we will soon be able to return again to two “in-person” Sunday worship services. When we believe that is feasible, and does not put any of our covenant partners at risk, we will do so.
